The Texas Agricultural Education & Heritage Center is a non-profit organization under section 501(c)(3) of the IRS code.

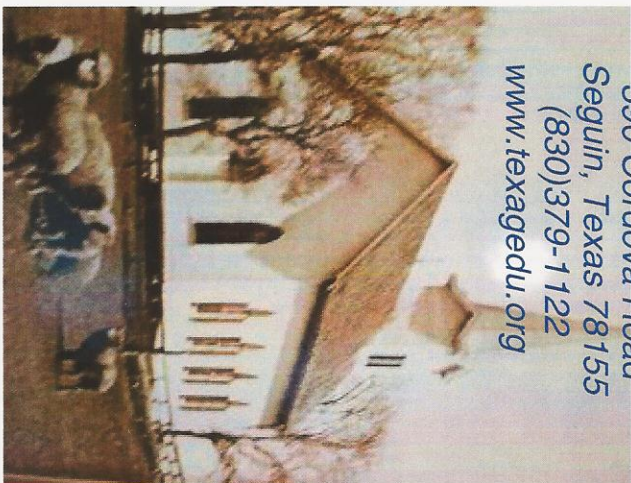

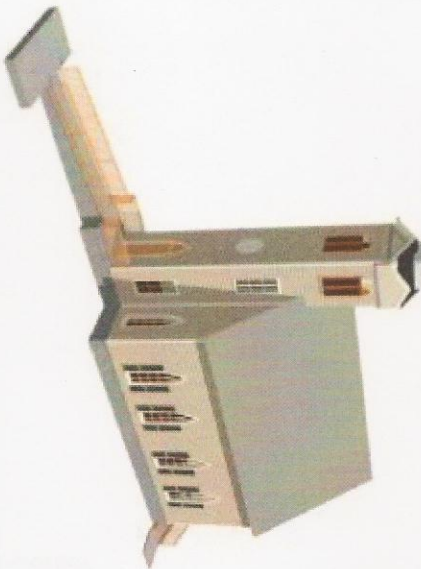
